ASCA Rules

These shows and trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program: a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Entry fees will not be refunded in the case a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot be opened or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fires, acts of God or public emergency.

AWARDS:

1st through 4th placement rosettes per class. Green qualifying ribbon for each qualifier. High in Trial will be awarded at each obedience and rally trial from the regular titling classes only. High Scoring Aussie, High Scoring Other Breed, High Combined and High in Trial Junior will be awarded at each trial.

ASCA Rules

ASCA Sanctioned obedience trials and rally trials are open to all breeds and mixed breeds eligible for registry with another club (including AKC and AMBOR). Bitches in heat are not allowed to compete. Bitches that come into heat or dogs that become injured before the pre-entry closing date may have their entries refunded pending proof by veterinarian. This is an actual trial and dogs of all breeds are eligible for titles. Dogs with titles or legs in other registries must begin at the novice level in ASCA. Visit the ASCA site for more details.
